


BASIS FOR MONUMENT LOCATION

1977 - PLS 1323 RAN AN EDM/THEODOLITE TRAVERSE OF SECTION 2 AND PARTS OF SECTIONS 3, 4, 9, AND 10. SET HARRISON IN A LOCATION THAT BEST FITS THE EXISTING CONDITIONS AFTER ANALYZING THE FIELD EVIDENCE, ORIGINAL GOVERNMENT NOTES, AND EXISTING CORNERS. THIS CORNER FALLS WITH IN THE BOUNDS OF A HIGH PRESSURE UNDERGROUND PETROLEUM LINE, DID NOT THINK IT WAS A WISE IDEA TO TAKE A BACKHOE INTO THE AREA. DUG A LARGE SEARCH HOLE BY HAND, BUT FOUND NO EVIDENCE OF THE ORIGINAL CORNER OR ANY REMONUMENTATION. THE CORNER FALLS ON THE SOUTH EDGE OF THE ASPHALT.

2019 - PLS 2675 FOUND RAILROAD SPIKE IN THE ROAD SURFACE, 1 TIE AND 3 WITNESSES. REMOVED THE RAILROAD SPIKE AND FOUND NO OTHER EVIDENCE OF ANY ADDITIONAL MONUMENTS BELOW. THE MONUMENT AGREES WITH THE TIES AND WITNESSES. ACCEPTED THE RAILROAD SPIKE AS THE CORNER LOCATION. RESET THE RAILROAD SPIKE IN THE LOCATION, SET 3 NEW TIES AND MEASURED TO THE EXISTING TIE AND WITNESSES.


